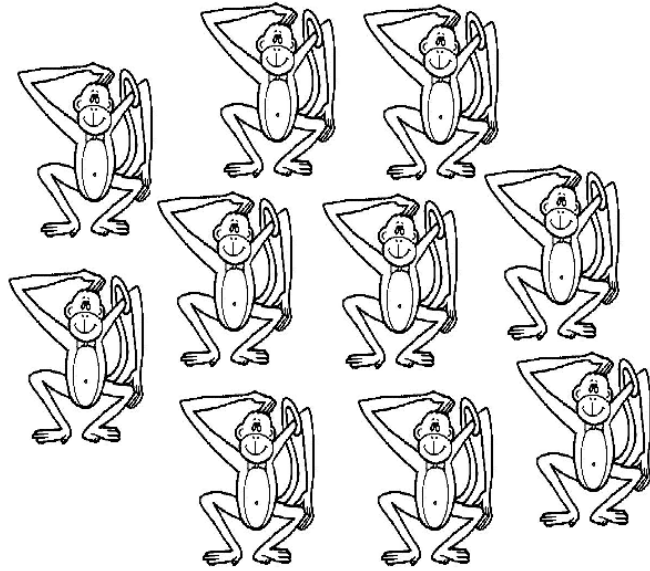
I went to the zoo,
And what did I see?



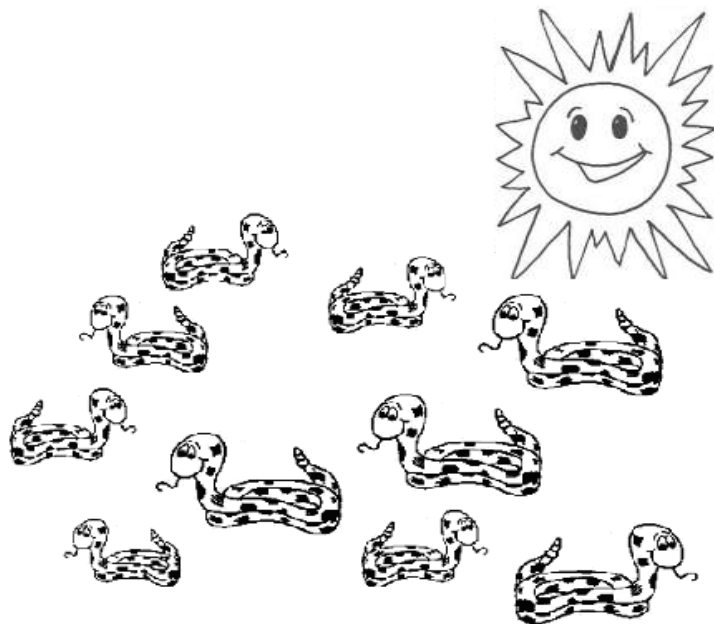
100 animals,
Looking at me.



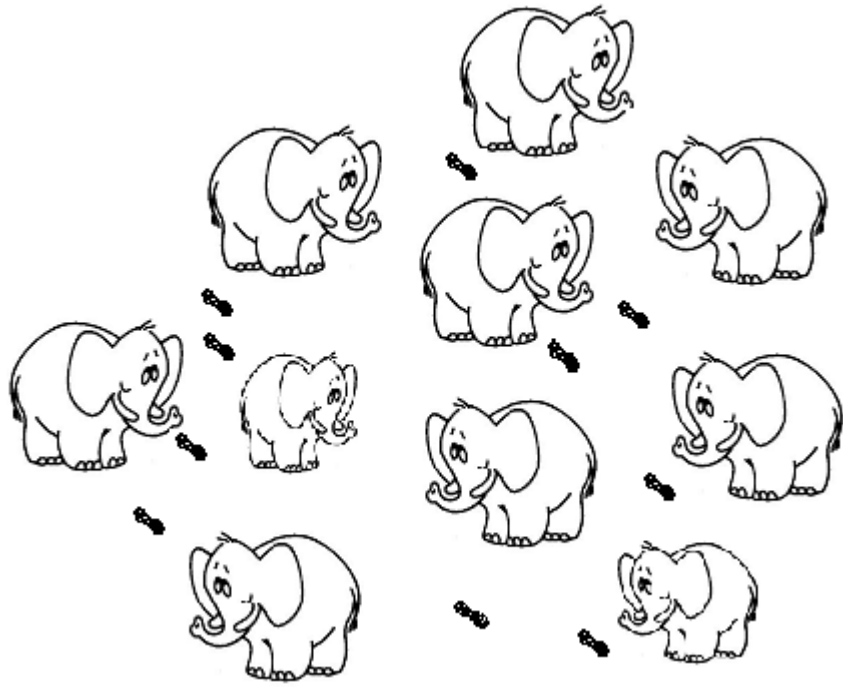
There were 10 tall giraffes,
eating from trees,



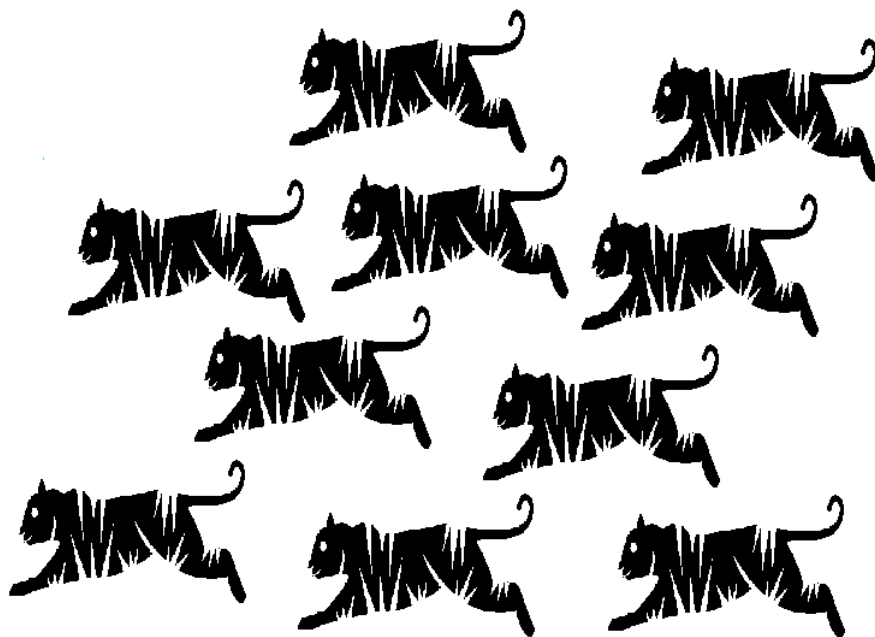
Ten silly monkeys,
scratching their heads.



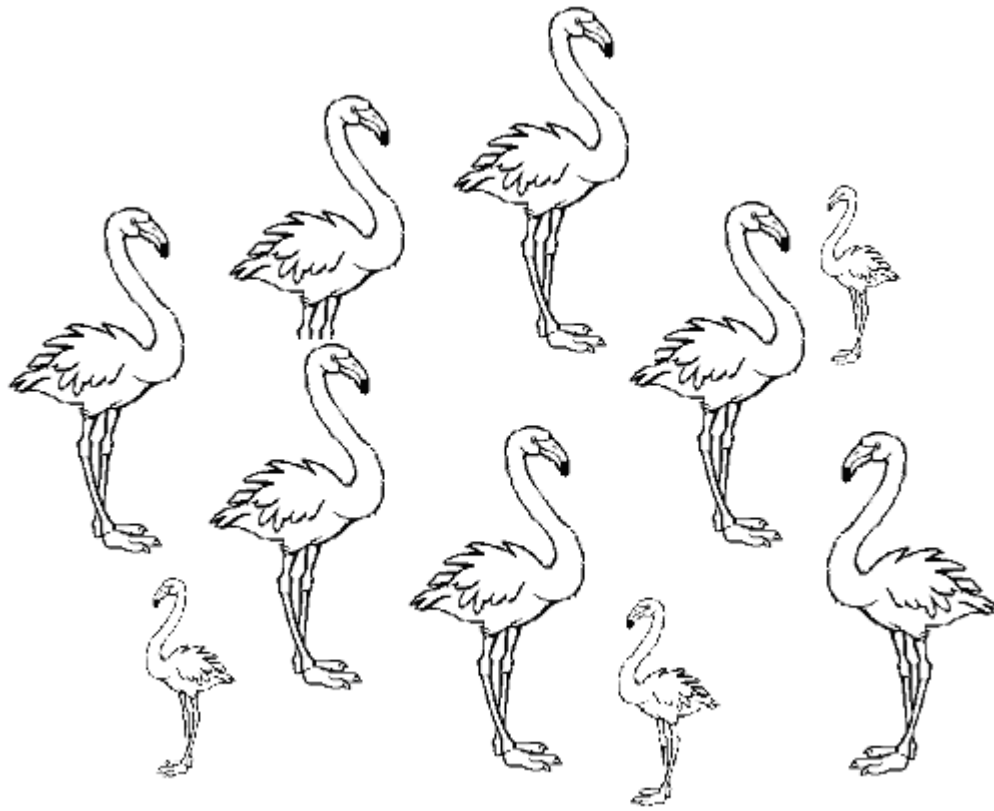
Ten sleeping snakes,
lying in the sun,



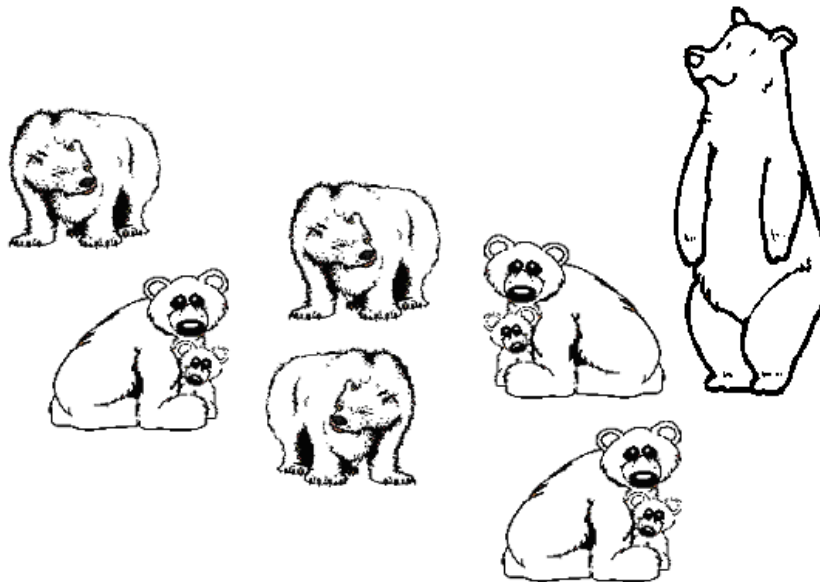
Ten munching elephants,

performing in the shows,



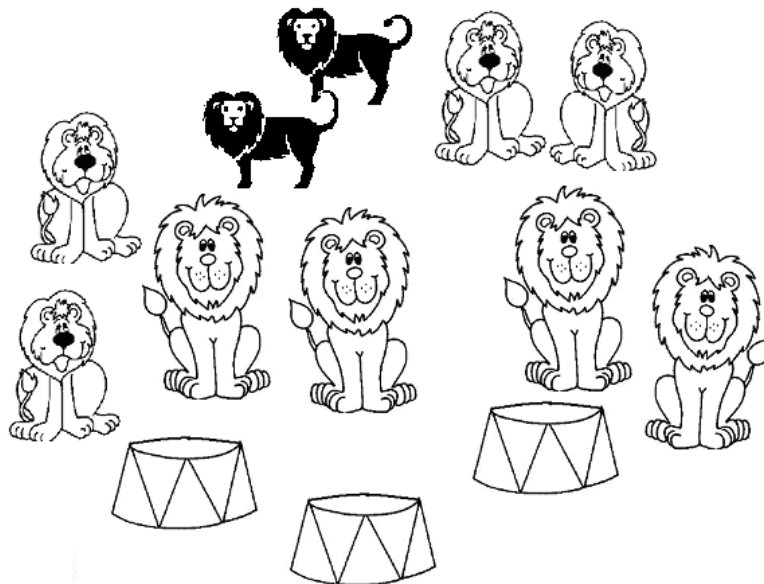
Ten pink flamingos,
standing on their toes.



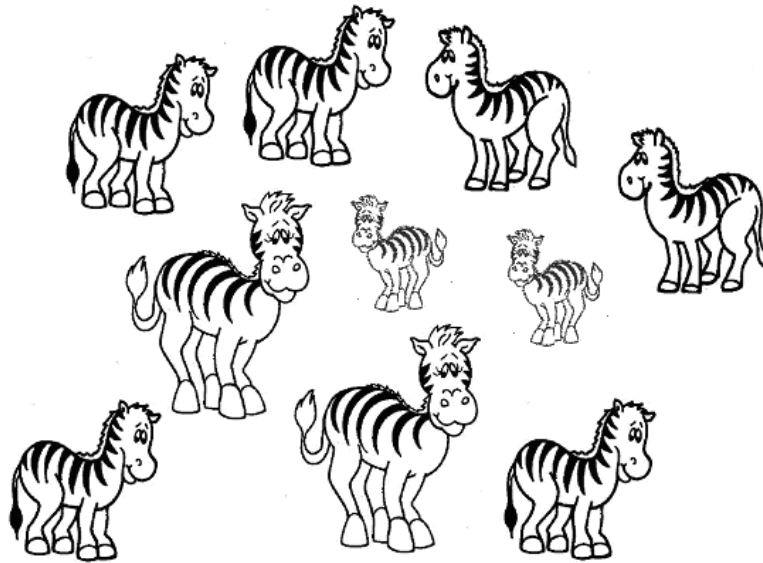
Ten grouchy bears,
